

Mobilities at Philipps-Universität Marburg (Germany)**in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA171****Objective**

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility offers the possibility to spend a period of teaching/training at **Philipps-Universität Marburg (Germany)** for **Teaching & administrative Staff** from the University of Sfax.

The **Erasmus+ Programme** is an initiative launched by the European Commission to fund mobilities among EU countries and between Programme Countries (EU countries) and Partner Countries (countries from the rest of the world). Every year, a new call for proposals will be open with the aim to promote socio-economic changes, jobs, social equity and inclusion.

Although the Erasmus program was initially addressed only to Programme Countries (EU), in 2015, for the first time, part of the EU funding will support mobility actions between Programme Countries and Partner Countries. To this respect, the Erasmus+ Programme is designed to support Programme Countries' efforts to efficiently use the potential of Europe's human talent and social capital, while confirming the principle of lifelong learning by linking support to formal, non-formal and informal learning throughout the education, training and youth fields. The Programme also enhances the opportunities for cooperation and mobility with Partner Countries, notably in the fields of higher education and youth.

Mobility periods

Staff Mobility period: 5 days

Winter term: 01. October – 31. March

Summer term: 01. April – 30. September

Conditions and procedures*General conditions for admittance*

- The candidate must be permanent Academic Staff at the **Philipps-Universität Marburg**
- To have a sufficient knowledge of English (B2).
- To submit a Mobility Agreement proposal, validated by the relevant institution authorities at the home university.
- For teaching activities (STA), a minimum of 8 teaching hours per 5 working days is required.
- Participants in ST mobilities contact their UM partners ahead of nomination to discuss the planed agenda for the mobility and the details for the Letter of Invitation.

Financing

A European Union contribution for subsistence: An amount established according to the country of destination and the actual number of days spent abroad. In particular, the grants are split into groups of countries according to the cost of living. the mobility contribution is 160 € per day. An additional amount to cover travel expenses. The amount is 275 €.

Evaluation and selection of applications

All the selection process at the home University will need to meet the criteria of transparency and equal opportunities for all applicants submitting their applications. The specific selection criteria and scale of assessment will be clearly established and published in the webpage and by any other means used to spread and announce the call.

Criteria for drafting the ranking list

The home university will provide a selection of candidates according to the following criteria:

- a. Relevance and impact of the work plan
- b. International activity
- c. Language skills
- d. Position held

Application Procedures

- Training agreement for administrative staff signed by the head of your institution (see annex)
- Teaching agreement for academic staff signed by the head of your institution (see annex)
- Copy of the Passport
- Knowledge of English (B1)
- Short CV
- Motivation letter
- Invitation letter
