No. 260, adopted following the Directorial Decree of 3 October 2023, prot. no. 167, containing ‘Notice for the granting of funding for transnational educational initiatives (TNE)’ - as part of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR), Mission 4 ‘Education and Research’ - Component 1 ‘Strengthening the provision of education services: from Nursery Schools to Universities’ – Investment 3.4, ‘Advanced University Teaching and Skills – Sub-investment T4 ‘Transnational Initiatives in education’, funded by the European Union – NextGenerationEU – CUP E11B24000500006.

#### Financial contribution

The ENGINES project will cover mobility expenses as outlined below:

- flight costs will be paid directly by UNIURB.
- accommodation and subsistence expenses will be supported through a daily allowance, granted to the selected candidates, amounting to € 250 per day (from the 1st to the 7th day), € 190 per day (from the 8th to the 14th day) and € 150 per day (from the 15th day onwards).

#### Eligibility

The Call for Applications is open to **Lecturers and Researchers** who:

- **are regularly** employed or under contract at one of the 6 African Universities listed below.
- **hold at least one teaching assignment** on one of the STE(A)M subjects - Science, Technology, Engineering (Art, including Culture & Heritage) and Mathematics as well as Humanities, Modern Languages, Sociology, Economics, Law and Sports Science, **at the Home University**.

**English proficiency.** A minimum B1 level of English is required to apply (according to the summary of Common European Framework Reference approved by the Council of Europe — for info visit <https://euopass.europa.eu/en/common-european-framework-reference-language-skills>).

## Required documents

The Application must include the following **mandatory documents**:

- Signed Application Form and authorisation to the processing of personal data (Annex A);
- Teaching Mobility Proposal (Annex B), clearly stating the program or the project to be carried out during the mobility and duly signed by the Applicant and by the responsible person at the Home University.
- Certificate of employment
- Academic Curriculum Vitae
- Passport copy
- Certificate of language proficiency in English.

**Professors are selected according to their academic experience:**

- Relevance and impact of the work plan
- International activity
- Scientific Curriculum.
- Linguistic capabilities.
- Position held.
- Other academic criteria selected by the committee

## Announcement of selection results

**N.B:**

- To be considered applications have to be submitted on time and supported with the necessary documents.
- Applications will be evaluated according to professors' academic files and the interview.
- A good knowledge of English is required for all professors.
- Selected professors for the MARE grant are not allowed to receive any other funds or work for the same period of teaching or research.

## Grant Agreement

The staff awarded a mobility must sign the **Grant Agreement**, which establishes the rights and obligations between the professor and the University of Urbino within the framework of international mobility, including for the purpose of financial contribution disbursement. The contract specifies the period and duration of the mobility, as outlined in the **Mobility Agreement**.

Mobility can only begin once the agreement has been signed by all parties involved.
