Online Summer School „Be Romanian – Be European”
from August 1, 2025

The online summer school offers **Romanian language and civilization courses** to foreign citizens who are motivated to learn Romanian in an **intensive** and **flexible** format.

The courses are taught by instructors specialized in teaching Romanian as a foreign language. Instruction will be delivered with the help of English. At the end of each module, a participation certificate will be issued and the participants' language skills will be assessed.

Participants may enroll in one or more modules. Registration and payment are done separately for each module.

After completing all three modules, participants may take the exam to obtain the B1-level language proficiency certificate.
