

The Aim and Importance of the Congress

Within the scope of "2025 Year of the Family", 'International Family Studies Congress' will be held between 23-25 October 2025 hosted by Kırıkkale University.

The primary goal of this event is to provide a multidisciplinary international forum for academicians and graduate students engaged in family studies to exchange knowledge and experiences through the presentation of their scientific studies and research, as well as to suggest solutions to advance the field.

Within the scope of the Congress, paper presentations in the main areas related to the family will be held face-to-face, online and by video recording. After the papers submitted to the Congress are evaluated by the Scientific Committee, the accepted full papers will be published as articles in a special issue called "Family Studies" in Kırıkkale University Journal of Social Sciences after the Congress.
