

**Scholarships to study at
Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu - Romania

Objective :

The Erasmus+ Programme – Mobility for study offers the possibility to spend a period of studies at **Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu** for **Bachelor, Master and PhD** Students from the University of Sfax.

All passed exams previously approved in the **Learning Agreement**, will be recognised by the home institution (University of Sfax).

Mobility periods :

Academic Year: **2026/2027**

Semester: **1st**

Fields of Education and Training :

- Food processing

Financing:

- **800 €** per month: subsistence support
- **309 €**: travel support
- The students will receive 80 % of the total grant in Sibiu, after signing the grant agreement (in the first 2-3 weeks of their mobility). 20% will be transferred in their bank account after mobility

Conditions and procedures:

The candidate student must be enrolled at the University of Sfax that signed the Inter Institutional Agreement within the framework of Erasmus + Programme, with **Lucian Blaga University of Sibiu**
The student must be **preselected** and **nominated** by the University of Sfax

Evaluation and selection of applications:

All the selection process at the home University will need to meet the criteria of transparency and equal opportunities for all applicants submitting their applications. The specific selection criteria and scale of assessment will be clearly established and published in the webpage and by any other means used to spread and announce the call.

Pre-selection criteria at the home university:

The home university will provide a pre-selection of candidates according to the following general criteria:

Students who meet one or more of the following inclusion and diversity criteria established by the Erasmus+ program:

- disability (i.e. participants with special needs): people with mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities.
- educational difficulties: young people with learning difficulties; early school-leavers; low qualified adults; young people with poor school performance.
- economic obstacles: people with a low standard of living, low income, dependence on social welfare system or homeless; young people in long-term unemployment or poverty; people in debt or with financial problems.

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- cultural differences: immigrants or refugees or descendants from immigrant or refugee families; people belonging to a national or ethnic minority; people with linguistic adaptation and cultural inclusion difficulties.
- health problems: people with chronic health problems, severe illnesses, or psychiatric conditions.
- social obstacles: people facing discrimination because of gender, age, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, disability, etc.; people with limited social skills or anti-social or risky behaviors; people in a precarious situation; (ex-)offenders, (ex-)drug or alcohol abusers; young and/or single parents; orphans.
- geographical obstacles: people from remote or rural areas; people living in small islands or in peripheral regions; people from urban problem zones; people from less serviced areas (limited public transport, poor facilities).
