

**Prolongation : Scholarships to study at LUM University - Italy
in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA171****Objective**

The Erasmus+ Programme –mobility for study offers the possibility to spend a period of **studies/traineeships** at **LUM University – Italy** for **Engineering students** from the University of Sfax.

Mobility students will be awarded a scholarship, will attend courses/traineeships and will use all the facilities of LUM University on an equal basis as the enrolled students.

All passed exams previously approved in the **Learning Agreement**, will be recognised by the home institution (University of Sfax).

Mobility periods

Engineering students: 5 months

Fields of Education and Training

Financing

The Erasmus+ for study scholarships are contributions to support living costs in the hosting country.
Monthly Scholarship: **850 €**
Travel costs: **275 €**

Conditions and procedures*General conditions for admittance*

The candidate student must be enrolled at the University of Sfax that signed the Inter Institutional Agreement within the framework of Erasmus + Programme, with **LUM University – Italy**

Please find the relevant dates for this first semester awarding period (September 2025/January 2026)

The student must be **preselected** and **nominated** by the University of Sfax, students will have a Skype Interview in accordance to which the final acceptance decision shall be taken.

Pre-selection criteria at the home university

The home university will provide a pre-selection of candidates according to the following general criteria:

- Average grade.
- The consistency of the proposed activities.
- Language skills.
- Any other elements indicated by the student in the application (other learning experiences, specific academic interests, etc.).
- Additional criteria i.e: membership in science clubs or associations, participation in conferences and other mobility programmes etc. (it is up to the sending institution to include the criteria or not)
- Students who meet one or more of the following inclusion and diversity criteria established by the Erasmus+ program:
 - disability (i.e. participants with special needs): people with mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities;
 - educational difficulties: young people with learning difficulties; early school-leavers; low qualified adults; young people with poor school performance.
 - economic obstacles: people with a low standard of living, low income, dependence on social welfare system or homeless; young people in long-term unemployment or poverty; people in debt or with financial problems.
 - cultural differences: immigrants or refugees or descendants from immigrant or refugee families; people belonging to a national or ethnic minority; people with linguistic adaptation and cultural inclusion difficulties.
 - health problems: people with chronic health problems, severe illnesses, or psychiatric conditions.
 - social obstacles: people facing discrimination because of gender, age, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, disability, etc.; people with limited social skills or anti-social or risky behaviors; people in a precarious situation; (ex-)offenders, (ex-)drug or alcohol abusers; young and/or single parents; orphans.
 - geographical obstacles: people from remote or rural areas; people living in small islands or in peripheral regions; people from urban problem zones; people from less serviced areas (limited public transport, poor facilities).

- Official transcript of records in English (From the Bac)
- Acknowledgement of enrolment
- Short CV
- Motivation letter
- Learning Agreement signed by the student, the academic tutor and the director of the home institution (see Annex) Please complete only "Before the mobility section Table A & Table B"

An incomplete application will be considered ineligible.

All the submitted documents must be in English.

Applications must be signed and approved by: Director of Studies, Head of Department and General Secretary.
