



Call for Applications (Prolongation) Teaching mobilities at Riga Technical University (Latvia) in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA1

Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility for teaching offers the possibility to spend a period of **teaching** at **Riga Technical University** for **Teaching Staff** from the University of Sfax.

The Erasmus+ Programme offers staff the chance to gain cultural experience abroad, become familiar with other higher education systems and meet people from other countries, actively contributing to the process of international integration.

Mobility periods: 7 days including travel

Funding

About grants

In the framework of the Erasmus+ programme and according to its regulations, all mobility activities are conditional upon the signature of an interinstitutional agreement between **Riga Technical University** and the partner university before the start of the mobility.

Details of the scholarships

The grant includes:

- **A European Union contribution.** An amount established according to the country of destination and the actual number of days spent abroad. In particular, the grants are split into groups of countries according to the cost of living. Turkey is included in Group 2 and the mobility contribution is **140€ per day**
- An additional amount to cover travel expenses. **360€**

Application requirements

General Admission Requirements

- Mobility rationale and motivation
- Proposed mobility plan (the more detailed – the better!)
- At least a B2 level of English
- Staff who have not previously participated in the Erasmus+ exchange program will be given priority
- Staff who have received an invitation letter from the RTU department they wish to visit will be given priority
- Nationals of the countries of the partner institutions.
- The staff has to be permanent staff in the home University which must be a partner of Riga Technical University in the Erasmus+ frame.
- To submit a Mobility Agreement proposal, validated at both ends by the relevant academic authorities at the home university.

Selection process:

- Nominated staff will complete the RTU online application form
- Once the candidate submits their application, the specific department at RTU to which the candidate is applying reviews the application and either accepts or rejects the application
- The RTU Erasmus+ coordinator notifies the candidate and the home institution of whether the application has been successful.

Application documents

Applicants are required to submit a full application, including the following documents:

- Teaching Agreement (Annex I)
- Invitation letter
- Copy of the Passport
- Short CV
- Motivation letter

Fields of Education and Training

- Faculty of architecture (master courses only).
- Faculty of computer science and information technology.
- Faculty of e-learning technologies and humanities (for translation majors only).
- Faculty of engineering economics and management (for economics/business/management majors only);
- Faculty of electronics and telecommunications.
- Faculty of power and electrical engineering.
- Faculty of mechanical engineering, transport and aeronautics.
- Faculty of materials science and applied chemistry.

Applications must be signed and approved by the home institution authorities.
