


Eligibility

- Applicants must have the following citizenship or nationality: **Algeria, Bahrain, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Syria, Tunisia, the West Bank/Gaza, or Yemen.** U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents are not eligible to apply.
- **Final year high school students or applicants who graduated from high school in 2025.** Applicants from Iraq, Libya, Syria, West Bank/Gaza, and Yemen who graduated high school in 2024 are also eligible.
- **Strong academic credentials.** After submitting their application, final year students must maintain their high academic achievement and pass their exit exams.
- **Maturity, adaptability, and leadership potential.**
- **Proficiency in written and spoken English.** Minimum TOEFL iBT score of 80, received within two years of the program start date, is required for university admission.
- **Ability to travel and start university in August 2026.**
- **Demonstrate financial need.** Applicants should be economically deserving students and should provide supporting financial documentation.
